## **ANNOUNCEMENT ON THE COMPETITION**

- I. The architectural competition for the project of restoring the entire western frontage of Piłsudski Square together with the Saxon Palace and the Brühl Palace is the greatest architectural and urban planning challenge of recent decades. This project is an important step in the process of commemorating the history of the Polish State and its Capital.
  
- II. The reconstruction of these buildings means not only restoring their external architectural shape, which they had on August 31, 1939, but also the need for a creative approach to designing their interiors in a way that will enable them to perform new functions, as well as the possibility of creative interpretation of the external form of these buildings in accordance with the Functional and Usage Guidelines.
